Furniture and Equipment: Sizes, Spacing, and Arrangement is not excessive but is not necessary If there is even a narrow shelf over the back of the working surface, a depth of 27 inches is recommended, because the shelf tends to interfere with overhead lighting

Anthropometric dimensions for each population are ranked by size and described as percentiles It is common practice to design for the 5th percentile (5th%) female to the 95th percentile (95th%) male The 5th% female value for a particular dimension (eg sitting height) usually represents the smallest measurement for design in a population
